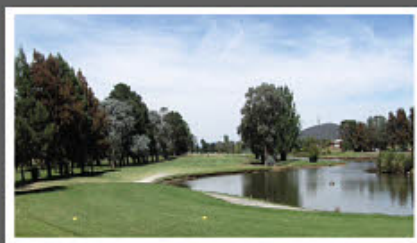

All rounds will be morning and afternoon shotgun starts and include a separate right handed partners competition

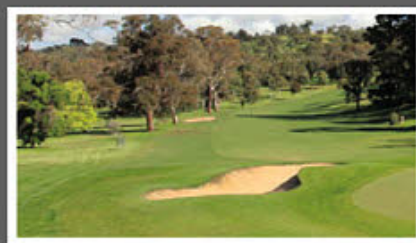

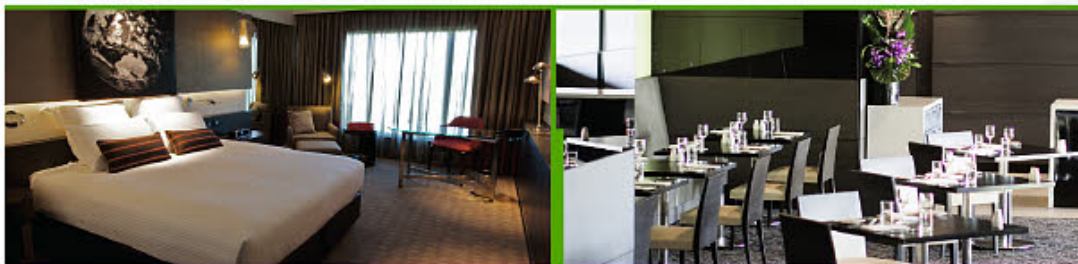

Immaculate conditioned sand belt course rated 46 best course in the country with excellent bunkering and home of the Australian Masters for many years.



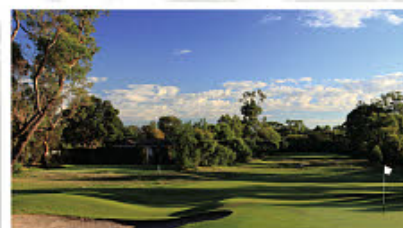
The National Golf Club – Long Island Course ▶
